Re: NOTICE OF DENIAL of MEP Class C License Application and
Opportunity for a Hearing

Mr. Morton:

Please be advised that the Mississippi State Fire Marshal Office (SFO) has carefully reviewed and considered your application for Mississippi Electronic Protection License - Class C. The Department wishes to advise you that your application has been **DENIED**.

Miss. Code Ann. § 73-69-11(2) (c)(Rev. 2013), permits the SFO to deny the issuance of a license to a convicted felon. Our criminal history records show you were convicted of burglary on or around June 6, 1988 and received a sentence of 3 years. Given the nature of the crime and the importance of protecting the public, the SFO is denying your Class C – System Installer application.

Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 73-69-11(9) (Rev. 2014), you are entitled to a formal hearing before the SFO regarding your application for a privilege license. If you desire a formal hearing, you must send your demand for hearing to the SFO **within ten (10) days** of your receipt of this letter. Your request for a hearing must be in writing. Upon receipt of your written demand for formal hearing, it will be scheduled and held within 30 days.
