TO ALL COMPANIES WRITING HOSPITALIZATION, HEALTH AND ACCIDENT
INSURANCE IN MISSISSIPPI.

Any person soliciting insurance by telephone, letter, or in person, shall be considered an agent. The term "agent" shall apply to any person discussing insurance with any prospect for the purpose of enabling himself or another to make a sale. Such person shall be subject to the payment of a privilege license and all the penalties for failure to qualify as an agent, whether compensated by salary, fee or commission.
