Subject: CPAT License Renewal

CPAT is the state's pre-entry requirement into the NFPA 1001-I-II Fire Fighter course. All CPAT License holders were notified by the IAFF in January 2009, they must respond to the IAFF/IAFC CPAT Licensee compliance before March 31, 2009. After working closely with the MSCB and the State Fire Academy, the IAFF extended the deadline until June 1, 2009 for notification to the IAFF of compliance with the requirements of the CPAT Program. Failure to comply results in your license becoming invalid and a department would no longer be allowed to use the CPAT test.

Many departments holding a CPAT license have responded, however those departments that did not respond before the June 1, 2009 deadline will need to reapply to the IAFF for a CPAT license by completing the application electronically through the internet at www.iaff.org/safe/cpatlicense. There is no fee for the license.
