The Mississippi Insurance Department has recently received your insurance producer renewal application. The Department has been made aware of several administrative actions taken against your license in various states. Specifically, Virginia, California, Wyoming, Illinois, Ohio, Florida and Kentucky have taken administrative action against your license. Your failure to report these actions in conjunction with the underlying facts giving rise to the numerous administrative actions are in violation of Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71 (1) (a)-(h) and §83-17-81.


Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71 (2) (Rev. 2014), you are entitled to a formal hearing before this Department regarding your application for a privilege license. Please notify this Department, within ten (10) days, if you wish to proceed with a formal hearing and it will be scheduled within 30 days. In the alternative, you may withdraw your application by service of a written request to this Department. If you choose to withdraw your application, you will be eligible to reapply as soon as you end your probation and you supply the Department with proof thereof.
