FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Commissioner of Insurance of the State

of Mississippi (hereinafter "Commissioner"), by and through his specially designated appointee,

the Hon. Phillips Strickland (hereinafter "Hearing Officer"), the hearing being held via toll free

teleconference, pursuant to the provisions of Mississippi Administrative Code Title 19, Part 1,

Chapter 44 (Dept. of Ins. Administrative Hearing Procedures Specific to Covid-19). on Tuesday,

September 8, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., pursuant to a Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges

brought against JOHN PATRICK MCBRIDE ("Respondent") dated July 29, 2020. Respondent

was properly served with and received notice of the hearing, and Respondent did telephonically

appear at and participate in the hearing. The Commissioner, based on the evidence presented at

the hearing, makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

1. The Respondent was convicted in a United States Marine Corps, Special Court-

Martial, on or about February 20, 2003, for a violation of Article 134, UCMJ.

2. Respondent provided incorrect and materially untrue information on his

Mississippi Insurance Producer License Application, by answering the question "Have you ever

been convicted of a military offense, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently

charged with committing a military offense?" with the response "No". The license application was

submitted by Respondent to the Mississippi Insurance Department on or about July 24, 2019. This

was a violation of the provisions of *Miss. Code § 83-17-71(1)(a) (Supp. 2019)*, and the allegations of Charge 1 of the Statement of Charges are well founded.

3. The attorney for the Mississippi Insurance Department moved to dismiss Charges 2 and 3 of the Statement of Charges. The motion is well taken and Charges 2 and 3 should be and hereby are dismissed.

4. The Respondent's current Non-Resident Insurance Producer License with the State of Mississippi expires on September 30, 2020.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That Respondent, John Patrick McBride, is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$250.00 pursuant to the provisions of *Miss. Code §83-17-71 (Supp. 2019)*.

2. That the Respondent's Non-Resident Insurance Producer License No. 19234497, or any other privilege license through the Office of the Mississippi Insurance Commissioner, shall not be issued or renewed unless and until the fine imposed herein has been paid in full.
