The Mississippi Insurance Department has recently received your application for a resident life, health and accident insurance agent license. You disclosed in your application that you have been convicted of a felony and are currently on probation. Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71(1) (f) (Supp. 2013), provides that the Commissioner of Insurance may refuse to issue or renew a license for anyone who has been convicted of a felony. It is the Commissioner's position that he will not issue a license while a person is still serving probation as part of a felony conviction.

Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71 (2) (Supp. 2013), you are entitled to a formal hearing before this Department regarding your application for a privilege license. Please notify this Department, within ten (10) days, if you wish to proceed with a formal hearing and it will be scheduled within 30 days. In the alternative, you may withdraw your application by service of a written request to this Department. If you choose to withdraw your application, you will be eligible to reapply as soon as you end your probation and you supply the Department with proof thereof.
