FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Commissioner of Insurance of the State

of Mississippi (hereinafter "Commissioner"), by and through his specially designated appointee

Mark Lampton (hereinafter "Hearing Officer"), in the Office of the Commissioner, 10<sup>th</sup> Floor,

Woolfolk State Office Building, 501 North West Street, Jackson, MS 39205, on Wednesday,

March 29, 2017, at 10:30 a.m., pursuant to a Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges

brought against Lee M. Jackson, Jr. ("Respondent") on March 1, 2017. After service and

notice, Respondent appeared and gave testimony at the hearing. The Commissioner, based on the

evidence presented at the hearing, makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

After considering all of the evidence and testimony presented, the Commissioner makes

the following findings of fact:

1. Respondent received the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges.

2. On March 29, 2017, the Hearing was held. Respondent appeared and gave testimony.

3. Respondent admitted to falsely submitting persons as part of an employer group, Mary

Kay, Inc., in order to obtain payroll rates for applicants when such persons were not actually

employees of said business.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Respondent violated Miss. Code Ann. §83-17-71 (1) (h) by using dishonest practices in the conduct of business in this state.

## **ORDER**

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Respondent pay a FINE in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) within 30 days from the date of this ORDER.

**ADDITIONALLY, IT IS ORDERED** that Respondent's insurance producer license be placed on **PROBATION** for a period of (1) ONE YEAR from the date of this Order with the condition that he not commit any additional violations of the insurance laws of this state.

Should the Respondent wish to appeal the Order of the Commissioner, he may follow the procedure set forth in Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71.
