NOTICE OF DENIAL of MEP Class D License Application and

Opportunity for a Hearing

Mr. Duthu:

Please be advised that the Mississippi State Fire Marshal Office (SFO) has carefully reviewed and considered your application for Mississippi Electronic Protection License - Class C. The Department wishes to advise you that your application has been <u>DENIED</u>.

Miss. Code Ann. § 73-69-11(2) (c) (Rev. 2013), prohibits the issuance of a license to a convicted felon more than 10 years from application date if it was a crime of violence. Our criminal history records show you were convicted of voluntary manslaughter in the 297th District Court of Tarrant County, Texas on or around January 28, 1992. Therefore, the SFO is prohibited from issuing you a MEP Class D license.

Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 73-69-11(9) (Rev. 2014), you are entitled to a formal hearing before the SFO regarding your application for a privilege license. If you desire a formal hearing, you must send your demand for hearing to the SFO within ten (10) days of your receipt of this letter. Your request for a hearing must be in writing. Upon receipt of your written demand for formal hearing, it will be scheduled and held within 30 days.
