FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This matter was set for hearing before the designee for the Commissioner of Insurance of

the State of Mississippi ("Commissioner"), on the Notice of Statement of Charges and

Opportunity for Hearing against Wardean Whitt ("Respondent"). Having been given notice of

the Statement of Charges against her and the time, date and place of the hearing, Respondent did

not appear. The Commissioner, being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. At the time of the hearing and at all other times relevant herein, Respondent was licensed

as a Resident Producer, Life, Accident and Health. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the

parties and the subject matter herein.

2. Substantial evidence shows that on or about December 23, 2008, Respondent caused two

(2) life insurance policies to be issued by Liberty National Life Insurance Company on the life of

Heather Dawn Purvis without Ms. Purvis's knowledge or consent. Through her previous

employment with the Mississippi Department of Health, Respondent improperly obtained certain

of Ms. Purvis's personal information and used such information to have the aforesaid policies

issued. Respondent used her own bank account to pay the policy premiums, and did so to obtain

a commission and a sales bonus from Liberty National Life Insurance Company.

3. Respondent's actions constitute fraudulent and dishonest practices and demonstrates

untrustworthiness in the conduct of business in this state in violation of Miss. Code Ann. §83-17-

1

71(1)(h). Respondent's insurance producer license should be revoked.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent's Resident Producer-Life, Accident and Health license shall be and hereby is revoked, effective immediately.
