Please be advised that the Mississippi Department of Insurance (Department) has carefully reviewed and considered your application for a Non-Resident Property & Casualty insurance producer's license in the State of Mississippi. The Department wishes to advise you that your application has been **DENIED**.

On October 06, 2008 the Department sent you correspondence by certified mail to your last known address advising you that pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71 (1) (Supp. 2005) the Commissioner of Insurance may refuse to issue or renew a license for failure to comply with a child support obligation. Said correspondence is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A."** 

It is the Commissioner's position that he will not issue a license while a child support obligation is delinquent. The initial correspondence requested either evidence that your child support is current or notification within ten (10) days of a request for a hearing on this matter. To date, you have failed to respond to our request therefore making it necessary for us to take the foregoing action against you.

Re: Non-Resident License Application

Dear Mr. Lorenzo

The Mississippi Insurance Department has reviewed your application for a non-resident insurance license. You disclosed in your application that you are delinquent on a child support obligation, but you failed to enclose any court documents indicating the amount of your child support obligation as well as neglecting to provide proof that you are currently making child support payments and/or paying an amount towards any arrearage that you may have accrued. Please be advised that Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71(1) (Supp. 2005) provides that the Commissioner of Insurance may refuse to issue or renew a license for failure to comply with a child support obligation. It is the Commissioner's position that he will not issue a license while a child support obligation is delinquent.

Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71 (2) (Supp. 2005), you are entitled to a formal hearing before this Department regarding your application for a privilege license. Please notify this Department, within ten (10) days, if you wish to proceed with a formal hearing and it will be scheduled within 30 days. In the alternative, you may pay your child support up to date and present evidence that it is current, or supply proof, such as a letter from the appropriate state human services department that you are currently complying with an order to pay current and delinquent child support payments, or withdraw your application by service of a current and delinquent child support payments, or withdraw your application, you will be written request to this Department. If you choose to withdraw your application, you will be eligible to reapply as soon as your child support payments are brought current and you supply the Department with proof thereof, otherwise, you will not be able to reapply within one (1) year of this letter.
