ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This matter came on for hearing on October 29, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. before the Commissioner of Insurance for the State of Mississippi (hereinafter the "Commissioner"), by and through his specially designated appointee, the Hon. Brandon White (hereinafter "Hearing Officer"), in the Office of the Commissioner, 10th Floor, Woolfolk State Office Building, 501 North West Street, Jackson, MS 39205, pursuant to the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges (Exhibit S-1) against We Insure Florida (hereinafter "Respondent"), having Mississippi Third Party Administrator License # 15019321. Respondent after being duly and properly notified of said hearing in accordance with statutory requirements did fail to appear and was found in default. Such hearing was held in the offices of the Mississippi Department of Insurance (hereinafter "Department"), 10th Floor, Woolfolk State Office Building, 501 North West Street, Jackson, Mississippi. The Commissioner, based upon the evidence presented at the hearing, makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law by clear and convincing evidence:

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

The Respondent, We Insure Florida, has failed to comply with the requirements of Miss. Code Annotated, § 83-18-27, in that Respondent has not filed the required annual report for the year 2013, which became delinquent after March 1, 2014. Furthermore,

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Respondent has failed to pay the filing fee required and due with the filing of the annual report, which became delinquent after March 1, 2014.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Π.

Pursuant to the authority specified in Miss. Code Annotated §§ 83-18-3(3) and 83-18-29, the certificate of authority / license of the Respondent to engage in the business of Third Party Administrator in Mississippi, through Mississippi privilege license number 15019321, should be revoked. In addition, the Respondent should be assessed an administrative fine in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) payable to the Mississippi Department of Insurance and due immediately.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the charges stated against the Respondent, We Insure Florida, should be and by the same are hereby sustained.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the license granted to the Respondent, We Insure Florida, by the Commissioner, under privilege license number 15019321, to act as a Third Party Administrator in the State of Mississippi, is hereby REVOKED effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Respondent is hereby assessed an administrative fine in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), which shall be payable to the Mississippi Department of Insurance and due immediately.
