ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter, having been set to come before the Commissioner of Insurance for hearing on November 8, 2018, regarding the above-captioned matter taken against Respondent by the Mississippi Department of Insurance (hereinafter "Department"), and based on the evidence presented, the Commissioner of Insurance does hereby **ORDER AND ADJUDGE** as follows:

1.

Respondent is a Mississippi non-resident insurance producer and holds Mississippi Privilege License No. 10469237.

2.

The Department sent a Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges ("Notice") to Respondent, on October 9, 2018, advising the Respondent of the Department's intention to revoke his non-resident insurance producer's license issued by the State of Mississippi Pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71, a hearing was set for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 8, 2018. Respondent was properly served by certified mail with the hearing notice. After being properly served, Respondent failed to appear and defend.

3.

The Notice referenced the following violation against Respondent, <u>Miss. Code Ann.</u> Section 83-17-81(2), in that such insurance producer failed to report to the Commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in this state within thirty (30) days of the final disposition of the matter. Specifically, Respondent failed to advise the Department that his nonresident insurance

producer's license had been revoked by the following jurisdictions: Florida Department of Financial Services; Louisiana Department of Insurance; and Virginia State Corporation Commission.

4.

As Respondent has failed to appear after being properly served, and based on the evidence provided, the Respondent's Mississippi nonresident's insurance producer license is hereby **REVOKED**.
