RE: Unit Construction Permit Checklist

- 1. Please provide a full date (e.g. 2025-10-22), the premises name and street address, along with MS Unit ID Numbers (MSxxxXXX) if existing, and Unit Designation (HOTEL 1, ESC-UP, etc.) on all documents. Fill out one application form per Unit. We do not issue invoices until payment is received. Provide a cover letter with a description or narrative of the work to be performed.
- 2. Please provide a complete Scope of Work for the project you are proposing. This includes a list of new and re-used items, as applicable. Where safety clearances remain the same, such as refuge space above and below a car, you may state this in words. For a simple job, you may provide a letter as the Scope of Work.
- 3. Please provide a sketch or plans with the following information clearly written on the drawing. Prints should be on at least $11" \times 17"$ paper, except that $8.5" \times 11"$ is acceptable for a small area and/or large font:
- Date (Year-Month-Day) of document or update;
- Full name of person who designed this Unit;
- Name of the company who designed this Unit, on each set of drawings;
- Name of the premises;
- Address of the premises where the Unit is located;
- MS ID Number and Unit Designation;
- Applicable codes used. Version year must be specified;
- Room location details (such as 3rd floor, room number, etc.);
- Dimensions throughout hoistway and machine room, including refuge space, top and bottom of hoistway, electrical clearance in front of controller, disconnects, etc. Label equipment;
- North arrow on plan views;
- Vertical Platform Lift. Must indicate a commercial unit.
