## Mississippi Hosts Disaster Leadership Conference in Biloxi

JACKSON, Miss. – The Mississippi Insurance Department hosted a Disaster Leadership Conference, November 12-13, 2025, at the Beau Rivage Resort and Casino in Biloxi. The event was hosted in partnership with the Alabama Department of Insurance, the Arkansas Department of Insurance, the Louisiana Department of Insurance, the Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance, and the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. City and county leaders, including many Mississippi Coast mayors, attended.

"The threats we face today are more complex than ever. We're no longer dealing with isolated disasters, we're facing cascading impacts. A storm isn't just wind and rain anymore; it's power outages, supply chain disruptions, displaced families, and strained health systems. But when communication flows freely and trust is built before a crisis, we move faster, save more lives, and rebuild more effectively," Chaney said.
